Historic Houses and Gardens

Stroll around the grounds of Godinton House where delphiniums are a speciality or savour the peaceful setting of the woodland garden at Beech Court. Discover the stunning bluebells and autumn colours at Hole Park and for an extra special day, book onto a Fact or Fiction guided tour.

Enjoy international and home-grown talent at Revelation Ashford, the award-winning music and arts venue. Treat yourself to a ranger, photography day or overnight safari at The Big Cat Sanctuary, then relax and unwind at Green Farm Spa.

Family Fun

Steam along to medieval Bodiam Castle with the Kent & East Sussex Railway and then enjoy the animals and fun activities at the Rare Breeds Centre. Visit Howletts Wild Animal Park and Port Lympne Reserve home to some of the world's most endangered animals.

History and Heritage

Celebrate Ashford's railway heritage at the Borough Museum and see corn being ground at Willesborough Windmill. Watch local history come alive at Woodchurch and Tenterden Museums. Discover Morgan three-wheeled cars at Rolvenden and visit Stocks Windmill, Kent's tallest post mill built in 1781.



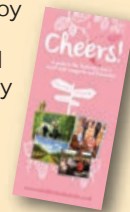
Shopping
