# **Our Building**

The Thanet Visitor Information Service is located in the coastal resort of Margate in Kent, fondly renowned as 'the original seaside destination'. Our Visitor Information

Centre is housed in the historic **Droit House**, on Margate's Harbour Arm, adjacent to the Turner Contemporary art gallery.

The approach to the building is flat. We have:

- An automatic door located at the side of the building for step-free access
- A Hearing Loop
- Magnifying Sheet
- Larger Print versions of our information sheets and maps available to collect,
   or send out by post
- We also welcome Assistance Dogs.

#### **Our Service**

We provide visitor information about Margate, Broadstairs, Ramsgate and the surrounding villages. We also hold information about attractions in Kent, London, and the South East.

Our range of services includes:

## **Getting Here**

## By Rail

- Nearest Rail Station: Margate. For accessibility information see:
   www.nationalrail.co.uk/stations/sjp/MAR/stationOverview.xhtml
- Our Information Centre is a 15 minute walk (0.7 miles) from Margate Rail Station. On exiting the Station, turn right, and walk parallel to the beach towards the Harbour Arm. Our iconic building can be seen across the bay, next to the Turner Contemporary Gallery.
- There is a taxi rank located to the right of the station forecourt.

## By Bus

- Most of the bus routes operated by Stagecoach use low-floor 'Easy Access' buses, which are wheelchair accessible.
- The most frequent bus services to and from Margate are:
  - <u>-The Loop:</u> runs every 7-10 minutes around the Isle of Thanet, via Margate, Broadstairs, and Ramsgate. Nearest stop: Cecil Square.
  - -The Breeze (# 8): runs every 15 minutes from Canterbury to Westwood Cross, via Margate. Nearest stop: Cecil Square
- Cecil Square is a 10 minute walk (downhill and flat) to our Centre, via the High Street and seafront, or along Cecil Street, Hawley Street, and King Street.
- Marine Terrace is also around 10 minutes on foot from the Centre and is a flat walk on pavement.

# By Car and Parking

- Sat NAV Postcode: CT9 1JD
- There are 6 designated Disabled Bays located outside Turner Contemporary.
   There are no time restrictions or charges for these bays for Blue Badge holders.
- There is also Pay & Display parking along the **Harbour Arm.** This is privately operated and does not offer Blue Badge parking. The surface is tarmacked.

Nearby Council-operated Car Parks are located within 5 minutes' walk of Droit House; Blue Badge Holders can use these free of charge.

- Market Street is located in the Old Town via a flat route, and is a short-stay
   Car Park, using Pay & Display (ticket machine or Pay by Phone). The area is
   tarmacked and contains 67 spaces, including 2 Disabled Bays.
- Trinity Square is located at the top of a steep hill, and is a long-stay Car Park, using Pay & Display (ticket machine or Pay by Phone). The area is tarmacked and contains 92 spaces, including 6 Disabled Bays.

## By Taxi

Please contact us directly on 01843 577577 for information on accessible taxi services.

The Old Town and surrounding areas are mainly paved; however, some parts of the roads are cobbled on The Parade. The most accessible route from Market Street to the Visitor Information Centre is to turn left when exiting the car park, and continue straight down until you reach the seafront road. Cross the main seafront road, and turn right along Marine Drive on the seafront side, until you reach the Harbour Arm. This side of the road is fully tarmacked.

## **Drop-off Point**

Visitors can be dropped off outside the Visitor Information Centre near to the entrance. The area around the building is completely flat with no kerbs.

#### **Entrance**

- The front of the building has 3 concrete steps plus 2 smaller door-steps with handrails either side, leading to inward-opening double doors. There is step-free access to the side of the building via an automatic door which is outward-opening.
- The front door opens into a corridor with laminated flooring, and the information centre is accessed through the opening on the right hand side.
   This opening is wide enough to accommodate a wheelchair.
- The step-free side entrance opens into the carpeted end of the corridor, and is wide enough to accommodate wheelchairs and most mobility scooters.
   Turn left into the corridor, and left again into the Information Centre.

**1st** - 21cm (8.5 inches)

2nd & 3rd- 16cm (6.5 inches)

4th - 9cm (3.5 inches)

5th - 11cm (4.5 inches)

Front Door: 111cm (44 inches)

Automatic Side Door: 111cm (44 inches)

VIC Entrance: 73cm (29 inches)

#### **Inside the Visitor Information Centre**

The Visitor Information Centre is a bright and airy space with plenty of natural light as well as fluorescent tube lighting. There is space around the leaflet racks for

wheelchair users or pushchairs to manoeuvre. The floor is flat and laminated. We do not play music, so can provide a quiet space.

## Accessible facilities include:

- Low level counter
- Hearing Loop system
- Notepad and pen available
- Magnifying sheet

Our leaflet racks are 190cm (75 inches) in height; if you require assistance, we're more than happy to help. A chair is always available if you need to sit down.

#### **Public Toilets**

- We do not have public toilets within the building.
- RADAR Keys for Accessible Toilets can be purchased from the Visitor
   Information Centre, and are required for using public Accessible Toilets.

The nearest public Accessible Toilets are located half-way along the Harbour

Arm.

• There are also public Accessible Toilets located within Turner Contemporary.
