

Welcome

A long stretch of sand and children's outdoor play area near by make Minnis Bay the perfect beach for a day in the sun. The Minnis Bay paddling pool is a great location to hunt for crabs and there is also an excellent restaurant with a bar and a kiosk on the prom.

At high tide, a small amount of beach remains, except at spring time when the beach can disappear until the tide moves out again.

- Walker Lane, Minnis Bay Bus route: Stagecoach no. 34 The bus stop is 0.00 miles / 54.7 km from Minnis Bay.
- The nearest train station is Birchington Railway Station. The train station is 1 miles / 1.6 km from Minnis Bay.

Parking

- There is parking near the venue. There are accessible parking spaces. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is not free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.

👗 Beach

- The beach access point is 100.00meters from the nearest car park.
- From the nearest car park to the beach, there is level access. The entrance is 5000mm wide.
- There are beach wheelchairs.
- There is a First Aid Station.
- RNLI weekends and Bank Holidays from 27th May to 7th July, then 7 days a week from 8th July to 3rd September.
- Bay Inspectors assist with minor first aid.
